INDIAN CANYONS GOLF RESORT TO OPEN HISTORIC NORTH COURSE TO THE PUBLIC NOVEMBER 1ST

PALM SPRINGS, CA (October 27, 2008) – Indian Canyons Golf Resort in Palm Springs, California will open its recently acquired North Course to the public for the first time in the course’s history, beginning Saturday, November 1st. The club’s popular South Course will open two weeks later, offering twice the wind-free golf on two distinct courses.

Over the years, North Course regulars included Frank Sinatra, Bob Hope, Jackie Gleason and Johnny Carson. Walt Disney, who owned several homes and donated the famous “Disney Fountain,” a gorgeous copper water sculpture located, between the 9th and 18th holes was also a regular on the links. Politicians including Former Presidents Lyndon B. Johnson, Gerald R. Ford, and Ronald Reagan also spent winters on the course. According to club folklore, the starter shack even had a “red phone” tied directly to the White House.

The North Course was acquired by Indian Canyons Golf Resort in September of this year. Once private, it opened in 1961 under the name Canyon Country Club. The course was designed by William P. Bell, the clubhouse by renowned architect Don Wexler.

It features a classically designed par-72, 18-hole championship course, with greens and fairways that meander through 6,943 yards of dramatic desert scenery. It includes private chipping and pitching areas, putting greens, plus six water hazards.

Indian Canyons Golf Resort’s first course, now known as the South Course, is just across the street from the North Course and will reopen November 15th. This beautiful, par-72, 18-hole championship public course was redesigned in 2004 by famed course architect Casey O’Callaghan, with LPGA Hall of Famer Amy Alcott serving as a consultant. The challenging design offers a dynamic assortment of curves and fairways spanning 6,582 yards. It features four large lakes which come into play on six holes, as well as five, 5-par holes and a 25-station driving range.
